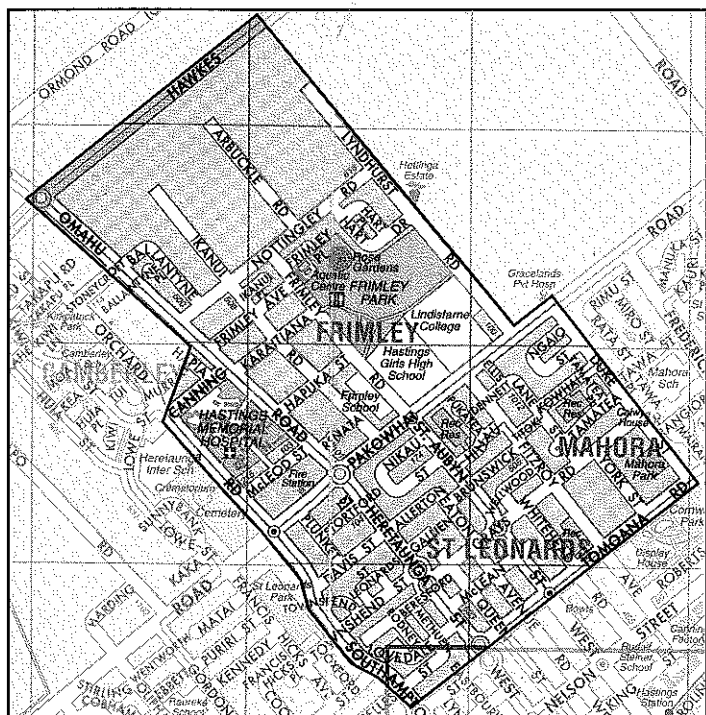


ENROLMENT HOMEZONE

PRE-ENROLMENT PROCEDURES FOR FRIMLEY PRIMARY SCHOOL

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme which is approved by the Ministry of Education until 2010. Details are available from the school office.

MOE has given the Frimley BOT permission to accept out of zone enrolments providing space exists at the class level required.

Parents of students who live within the home zone and intend enrolling their child at any time during 2008/2009/2010 should notify the school as soon as possible to assist the school to plan appropriately for the years ahead.

Students who live in the home zone are all entitled to enrol at Frimley School. Parents of children turning five are encouraged to enrol them as soon as they turn four.

Applications for Out of Zone Placements are to be made in writing on the school application form and addressed to the Principal which indicates which of the following priorities apply. This form is available from the school office.

| <u>First Priority</u> | This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary of Education. |
| <u>Second Priority</u> | will be given to applicants who are sibling of current students. |
| <u>Third Priority</u> | will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students. |
| <u>Fourth Priority</u> | will be given to applicants who are children of board employees. |
| <u>Fifth Priority</u> | will be given to all other applicants |

They must be received on the day prior to a BOT meeting or they will be placed on hold until the date of the next meeting.

If the number of out of zone applicants exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot assuming there are spaces available at the selected year level. If a ballot for out of zone places is required, it will be held on the dates listed. Parents will be informed of the outcome of the ballot within three school days of the ballot being held.

Out of zone applications may be considered at each B.O.T. meeting.
